The following sites have been registered at this ministry as protected areas for the purposes of preserving their nature and habitat under Article 4 of Law no. 4/93 Environmental Protection and Preservation Act. These sites have been registered to be overseen by the Ministry of Tourism.

- 1. Malé Atoll Makunudhoo atoll entrance, west of Makunudhoo. 73° 22'.
- 2. Rasfaree and the surrounding reef. 04° 24'N, 73° 20'E.
- 3. Thanburudhoo thila, west of Thanburudhoo. 04° 19'E, 73° 34' 5"E.
- 4. Gaathugiri or Ahdhashugiri Furaanafushi's west. 04° 14' 5"N. 73° 32'E.
- Giraavarukudahuraa, north of Giraavaru. 04° 13'N, 73° 24'5"E.
- Southwest side of Dhekunuthilafalhu's Miyaruvani Thilafalhu. 04° 11'N, 73° 24' 5"E. (Lion's
- 7. In the middle of Gulhi Falhu, south to the west of Gulhi Falhu. 04° 11'N, 73° 28'E. (Hans Hass Place).
- 8. Enboodhoo atoll entrance. 04° 05'N, 73° 32'E.
- 9. Guraidhoo atoll entrance, the atoll entrance to the west of Guraidhoo. 03° 54'N, 37° 28'E.
- 10. Ari Atoll Maya thila, on the northwest side of Mayafushi. 04° 05'N, 72° 51' 5"E.
- 11. Orimas thila, southwest of Maagu. 03° 59'N, 72° 57'E.
- 12. Mushimasmigili thila, southwest of Mushimasmigili. 03° 57' 5"N, E.
- 13. Kudarah thila, between Kudarah and Dhigurah. 03° 34'N, 72° 55'E.
- 14. Felidhe Atoll third atoll entrance from Miyarukandu alimathaa. 04° 34'N, 72° 51' 5"E.
- 15. Faadhihppolhu Fusheevaru thila, southeast of Fushifaru. 05° 29'N, 73° 31'E.

The following actions are prohibited in the aforementioned areas without written permission from this ministry after 1st October 1995.

- 1. Performing any action that could damage or bring changes to these areas and anything in the
- 2. Fishing of any type, other than bait fishing.
- 3. Removing and taking of rocks, sand, and coral from the area.
- 4. Taking or capturing anything from the sea, reef, or land of these areas.5. Dumping or throwing away anything in these areas.
- 6. Capturing, taking, and killing any birds in these areas.
- 7. Dropping anchor in these areas for any reason other than a situation in which a person or a vessel is in danger.
